This International Kinesiology Instructor Certification Program is accredited with the **International Kinesiology College (IKC)**, is endorsed world-wide and takes 8 days to complete. With over 1 million people having learnt a form of Touch for Health, here is the opportunity for anyone to be licensed to teach and share the most widely recognised of all kinesiology modalities which serves as a foundation and grass roots training to professional and practitioner training in kinesiology.

Touch For Health Kinesiology is a system of natural health care which combines muscle monitoring with the principles of Chinese medicine to assess energy and body function, applying a range of gentle, yet powerful healing techniques to improve health, wellbeing and vitality. TFH Kinesiology addresses the structural, nutritional and emotional stresses common in our everyday life. The synthesis of TFH techniques involves skills researched from modern chiropractic, naturopathy, osteopathy and ancient Chinese acupuncture.



Touch For Health uses the muscles as a bio-feedback mechanism. This becomes a greater tool that works at the connection between mind and body, using the electromagnetic energy system called meridians, which are the interface between the physical and subtle energy bodies. Raising energy then through the acupuncture meridian system allows the person to feel positive health benefits, encouraging the natural processes of the body to enhance health and vitality. Though TFH was written by Dr John Thie for the non-professional to use with their families and friends, more and more professional students are attending TFH classes. It is not just the chiropractor who uses kinesiology ... dentists, medical doctors, osteopaths, naturopaths, nurses etc are using TFH and many new kinesiology techniques are being offered by these people. More and more of the general public are familiar with Kinesiology and accepts muscle monitoring as a modern way of accessing imbalances, and correcting them. Several countries have introduced government accredited professional kinesiology training based on TFH.

At the completion of the **Touch For Health Trainers Workshop**, students will receive a Certificate of Teaching Competency and be licensed to teach TFH anywhere in the world. You will be licensed to teach the following IKC accredited courses:

Once you have taught 5 students in TFH and registered them with the IKC, you will receive the official IKC TFH Instructor Certificate. In Australia, the Touch For Health Trainers Workshop is recognised by the **Australian Kinesiology Association (AKA)** and the **Australian Institute of Kinesiologists (AIK)** and the completed hours may be used towards becoming an accredited member.

As a TFH Instructor, you will be teaching as part of a world-wide team, teaching from the same syllabus and using the same techniques as other TFH Instructors. On completion of the TFH Instructor Training, you are encouraged to teach anywhere in the world, helping individuals and students to understand that kinesiology empowers them to make better choices for their health and wellbeing.

Teaching Methods

A range of teaching methods are incorporated for delivery of course content as relevant to the subject. These include a combination of modified lectures utilizing visual aids, workbooks and handouts, class and group discussions, theory and practical exercises, demonstrations role plays and presentations

Course Fees

The ACKM fees for the TFH Trainers Workshop in 2010 are as follows:

Express Payment - \$2295.00

One initial full payment of **\$2295** at time of enrolment or an initial deposit of **\$595.00** followed by one up-front payment for the complete outstanding balance paid within 7 days before the commencement of the course.

NOTE: It is important to understand that our classes are limited in size and enrolments are accepted on a first-come first-serve basis. You are requested to lodge your enrolment and deposit with us as early as possible to ensure you have a seat reserved in our upcoming intake. On enrolment, a deposit of \$595.00 is required to secure class placement. The course fee included a \$95 ACKM enrolment fee. If you are an existing ACKM student and have paid this fee before then this \$95 is waived. Payments may be made by cheque, credit card, money order, direct debit. All credit card transactions incur an additional 2.5% processing fee.
